





Types of sellers



Wholesalers

Wholesalers make up the bulk of sellers on 1688.com. The majority have a minimum order quantity of only a few pieces, as well as a minimum spend amount. As a rule, wholesalers hold more inventory and stock than factories.



Brand owners

Brand owners are similar to wholesalers in that they offer a low minimum order quantity. However, while wholesalers will often sell white label goods, branded stores on 1688.com will operate a storefront with their brand name and logo.




Sourcing agents or virtual factories


Similar to an intermediary, these merchants help buyers find a reliable supplier, negotiate the best price, assist with documentation, coordinate with the factory or perhaps oversee the production to ensure it aligns with specifications. As sourcing agents, they don't hold stock; rather, they help to secure products within the promised lead time.



Factories & manufacturers

Factories specialise in receiving production orders, with the minimum order quantity (MOQ) starting at 1,000 pieces in some cases. There's a 'Find a Factory' option in the 1688.com app, which buyers can use to filter for factories in different categories. Generally, factories don't keep inventory but make products based on orders.





Setting Up Your 1688.com account

How to register for 1688.com?

There are two methods:



Method 1: Via Taobao (mobile)

- If you have a Taobao account, you can use the same login for 1688.com.
- Register through the Taobao app and link it to 1688.com automatically.

Method 2: Via 1688.com (PC)

- 1 Visit www.1688.com.
- 2 Click on the 免费注册 (Sign Up for Free) tab.



- 3 Fill in your registration details (name, mobile number, password).
- 4 Click 同意并注册 (Agree and Register).



Verify your mobile number by entering the OTP sent to your phone. Enter the code and submit by clicking 提交 (Submit).



Verifying your 1688.com account

Verification is highly recommended for seamless order processing, payments and account recovery.



Steps

- 1 Click on your account name → 账户管理 (Account Management).
- 2 Under 我的认证 (My Verification), select 我要认证 (I Want to Verify) under 个人认证 (Personal Verification).



- 3 Link your verified Alipay personal account to your 1688.com account.
- 4 Enter your Alipay login ID and password, then click to connect.





What is World Pay (跨境宝)?

World Pay is the official cross-border payment solution launched by Ant Group and 1688.com.



It allows international buyers to:



Pay 1688.com suppliers securely



Avoid account freezes caused by unverified payments



Make large payments without annual limits

How it works:



Add funds from your bank account into your WorldFirst account.

Make automated payments directly when purchasing on 1688.com.

Tip: Ensure you hold a sufficient CNH (Chinese Yuan Offshore) balance so your automatic payments are processed without interruption.

If you're unfamiliar with cross-border trade or face language barriers, you can hire a 1688.com sourcing agent.

How to verify supplier reliability



Check the supplier's store page for:

- Number of years operating on 1688.com
- Response rate and return rate
- · Buyer ratings and reviews
- Buyer protection offers
- Transaction history (compare with industry averages)



Sourcing Checklist

- Conduct product research/
 determine which products are
 best sourced from China
- Select a sourcing platform
- Decide whether to source directly from a supplier or use a sourcing agent
- Select a reliable supplier
- Verify supplier reliability



Tips

- Order a sample before making a large order.
- Confirm all details (price, material, MOQ, shipping) in writing
- Save chat logs as proof for any disputes later
- Use the Google Translate extension for quick translations

Communicating with suppliers

On 1688.com, communication is key — most sellers primarily speak Chinese, so you need to be clear, polite and efficient. It's one of the most important but sometimes most difficult aspects of product purchasing. A sourcing agent can help with translations and requests; without one, you have to rely on digital tools and your own abilities.

Main ways to communicate:



阿里旺旺 (AliWangWang):

1688.com's official messaging app (similar to WhatsApp, but for business)



In-browser chat:

Direct pop-up chat availableon desktop



WeChat:

Direct pop-up chat availableon desktop

Tips

- Use simple English or machine-translated Chinese (use Google Translate or DeepL)
- Keep messages short and clear avoid slang or complex sentences
- State your request upfront: quantity, customisation, shipping method



Examples of message templates

Example 1: Initial enquiry with a supplier

Hello, I am interested in your [Product Name].

Can you please send me the following information:

- Price for [quantity] units
- MOQ (Minimum Order Quantity)
- Available colours/sizes
- Shipping to [your country]

Thank you!

Example 2: Asking about customisation (OEM/ODM)

Hello, I would like to customise [Product Name] with my brand/logo.

Can you do OEM/ODM?

- · What is the MOQ for customisation?
- What is the sample cost and lead time?

Thank you!

Negotiation Tips

You can and should negotiate – it's expected in China's business culture.



Key points to negotiate:

- Price per unit (especially if you're buying larger quantities)
- Sample fees (sometimes refundable after an order)
- Customisation costs (printing logos, packaging)
- Shipping options and costs
- Payment terms (partial payment or full upfront payment)


Negotiation style:

- · Be polite but firm
- Build rapport ("I plan to place larger orders if the sample quality is good.")
- Always talk about long-term cooperation suppliers prioritise repeat customers
- Ask for a better price if ordering multiple products (combining SKUs)

Glossary of important Chinese terms

Making payments with WorldFirst's World Pay







Funding your WorldFirst account

Step-by-step process:


1 Create a new receiving account in your WorldFirst dashboard



2 Select a currency – in this case CNH




3 Give your receiving account a name to help you identify it

In summary:





Once payment is received, your supplier will process your order. You'll get confirmation via 1688.com and the WorldFirst dashboard.


Tips

- Pre-load your account before purchasing: It ensures you have enough funds ready for fast checkout.
- Double-check supplier information:
 Make sure the supplier name
 matches your intended payee.
- Confirm total payment amount:
 Check if the seller's price includes VAT (增值税) or if it's separate.
- Plan for currency movements: If your local currency is volatile, consider converting and holding CNH in your WorldFirst account in advance.
- Keep transaction records: This includes screenshots, invoices and WorldFirst receipts – helpful if any disputes arise.

Shipping and logistics

Essential guide to cross-border B2B Logistics: From China to Southeast Asia

With Southeast Asia booming as an e-commerce hotspot, more businesses are sourcing from China to access lower prices, wider product variety and scalable manufacturing. But once the goods are ready to ship, how do you get them across borders smoothly?

Shipping from China can feel opaque – especially when you're dealing with different freight quotes, complex customs paperwork and unpredictable delivery timelines.

This guide breaks down everything you need to know to get your shipments from China to Southeast Asia.

01. Choosing the right freight mode: Air, sea, or land?

For B2B importers, selecting the most suitable freight method involves balancing cost, speed and shipment size.

Mode	Best for	Cost
Air	Small to medium-sized, urgent shipments	Higher
Sea	Large, cost-sensitive orders	Economical
Land	Shipping to Central Asia (bordering China)	Mid-range

Key insight: Most importers prefer to use sea/land freight for inventory restocking and air freight for trending or perishable products requiring fast delivery.

Origin	Destination	Mode	Lead Time
China (CN)	Nigeria (NG)	Air	15–29 days
		Sea	59–79 days
China (CN)	Kazakhstan (KZ)	Land	7–25 days

China (CN)	Uzbekistan (UZ)	Land	18-25 days

Keyinsight: These are standard estimated timelines and may vary slightly based on the origin city in China, port congestion, customs clearance or seasonal demand. We recommend factoring in a buffer period to keep your business operations running smoothly.



02. Customs compliance: General documentation and regulatory tips

When you're moving goods across borders, proper documentation is vital. Missing or incorrect paperwork can stall your shipment at customs, trigger penalties or lead to rejection, especially in tightly regulated markets.





Logistics checklist

Review lead time estimates for each freight mode based on your destination country.				
Identify if your goods are urgent or perishable —air freight may be the most suitable option.				
Confirm which freight modes are available for your route and shipment size, and select the appropriate mode (air, sea, or land) based on your product, budget, and timeline.				
Plan delivery schedules with buffer time to account for peak seasons, customs delays, and port congestion.				
Customs & Compliance				
Research import regulations and taxes, or consult your forwarder for the latest requirements.				
Ensure all required documents and licenses for your commodity are prepared and regulations are met before shipping.	/			
Freight Forwarder Capabilities				
Look for a logistics partner who can support your end-to-end needs, including customs clearance and last-mile delivery.				
Ask for a full cost breakdown, including duties, warehousing, and handling fees.				
Inform your forwarder of your preferred incoterms and clarify both parties' responsibilities.				

Ensure they have experience handling Southeast Asian routes and are familiar with documentation nuances.



How to avoid pitfalls

First-time buyers often run into avoidable issues that can cost time and money. Here's how to avoid the most common problems:


Pitfall	What to watch for	How to avoid
Dealing with unreliable suppliers	Low ratings, fake product photos, unverified businesses	Look for the 诚信通 badge – it shows the supplier is verified. Check sales volume (成交量) and order samples first.
Poor product quality	Misleading product listings or lack of quality control	Always request a sample before making large orders. Confirm materials, specs, certifications.
Scams / Fraud	Suppliers asking for payment outside of 1688. com (WeChat personal account, bank wire)	Always pay via 1688.com + WorldFirst. Never pay directly to someone's personal bank account or by QR code.
Miscommunication (language barriers)	Important product details are misunderstood	Use clear, bullet-pointed messages. Confirm specs in writing. Translate carefully.
Hidden costs	Extra charges for shipping, packaging, VAT	Confirm total cost upfront (product + domestic shipping + international shipping + taxes). Get everything in writing.
Payment problems	Supplier changes price after payment	Finalise price inside the 1688.com order chat. Screenshots are your proof.
